



EXEMPTION FORM FOR AIR SHOW FLIGHTS

Qualified flights of aircraft taking part in air shows are exempt from NAV CANADA air navigation services charges. For the purpose of NAV CANADA air show exemptions, an air show is defined as an event where aircraft perform aerial displays and/or static demonstrations, where the public is invited.

For flights to qualify for an air show exemption, the following conditions must be met:

1. The aircraft must participate in an aerial or static demonstration at the air show, where a participation agreement is in place between the aircraft operator and the air show organizers, AND
2. The flight(s) must be operated exclusively:
 - a) as part of an official air show aerial display, OR
 - b) to transport the aircraft to or from the air show.
